

Week of 9/12/2016 Construction in the Main Street Cultural District

1. Replacement of sidewalk and curb in the 100 block of Main Street. The City will be working from the curb to the parking meters on the South side of the street Monday - Wednesday and on the North side of the street Wednesday - Friday. Work on the sidewalks in the 400 block of Douglas will begin September 19.
2. Clark Avenue will be closed from south of the Main Street intersection to the railroad tracks. This first phase is anticipated to last four to six weeks. Sidewalk access to businesses along the west side of Clark Avenue will be maintained at all times. However, there will be no access to public parking in Lot U.
3. Replacement the concrete vault lid underneath the alley north of the Sheldon-Munn Hotel. Parts of the alley, located between Kellogg and Burnett Avenues from Main Street to Fifth Street, will be closed for about 2 weeks. The parking lots accessed from Fifth Street and the western portion of the alley will remain open to traffic during construction. Vehicles in the area should expect construction vehicles and activities. For safety reasons, pets and children should be kept away from the construction zone.
