# PROGRAM OPTIONS



## DEMONSTRATIONS

Introduce your audience to the tradition of hand made prints. Our Printmaking 101 demonstration sessions provide a quick glimpse at the major print techniques. APS instructors explain each method while printing pre-made matrixes. Etching, block printing, screen print, monoprint, and paper litho are demonstrated. Specific topics can be customized just for you. *Great for all ages.*

## CHILDREN'S PRINTMAKING BOOTH AT COMMUNITY FESTIVALS

Enliven your event with a children's printmaking booth. Guidance by Atlanta Printmakers Studio instructors is provided to help children make colorful monoprints. APS provides all printing equipment and supplies. Host site must provide tables, water source, & drying area (i.e. clothes line or additional table). Everyone takes home the original print they created. *Great for all ages.*

## WORKSHOPS & MULTI-SESSION CLASSES

### MONOPRINTS: GREAT FOR ALL AGES

Participants combine stamps, stencils, textural items and printing ink on an acrylic plate to create imagery. These plates are then hand-cranked through a table-top printing press.

### RELIEF PRINTS WITH LINOLEUM: AGES 12 AND UP

Classes design, carve, ink, & print linoleum blocks. Classes will focus on single-block prints. Intermediate classes in multi-block printing are available.

### RELIEF PRINTS WITH FOAM: GREAT FOR ALL AGES

Participants draw onto styrofoam trays using nothing sharper than a pencil. These trays are then inked and printed. This workshop produces images similar to block printing but without the need for sharp carving tools.

### SCREEN PRINTS: AGES 12 AND UP

Images are generated by pushing ink through a stencil created on a mesh frame. Classes go thru the process of planning, creating, & printing their own designs.

### DRYPOINT ETCHING: AGES 12 AND UP

Images are drawn by scratching into a plexiglas plate. The plate is then inked and wiped for printing through an etching press. Classes go through the process of planning, creating, & printing their own designs.



## PRICES
