Responsibilities will include supporting OpporTUNEity faculty by collaborating with incarcerated adults on songwriting projects related to group writing exercises, lyric writing, composition, and performance. We welcome undergraduate students majoring or minoring in any area of music who are interested in diversifying their resumes and comfortable working in a correctional environment. Courses will be held inside of the Worcester County House of Corrections in Massachusetts. Time and mileage will be compensated.

Qualifications

Preference will be given to individuals who demonstrate competency on guitar, piano and/or drums. Songwriting experience and knowledge of music theory is preferred, but not required. Nonmajors with the aforementioned skills will be considered. Thick skin and a willingness to engage in off-color banter is a plus. Interns must be open to offering group feedback and suggestions in a constructive manner.
