The Summer Staff

Every summer, 55-60 summer staff come to Camp Hebron to serve over 1,500 campers and guests that attend our summer programs. Through the years, God has consistently blessed Camp Hebron with a Christ-centered staff, excited to serve others and share the good news of the gospel of Jesus Christ.

Our summer staff come from all over the U.S. (and occasionally abroad). They serve in a variety of areas: in the kitchen, as a counselor, in the barn, the pool and more. They complete a lengthy application, procure several references and have a personal interview, clearances and background checks, all designed to discern their motivation, maturity, and ability to serve in a camp ministry setting.

Many also make financial sacrifices to serve at Camp Hebron. Camp provides room and board and a weekly stipend starting at a base rate of \$135/week. We're fortunate that staff graciously accept the stipend we offer, choosing to serve at camp.

How Can I Support a Summer Staffer?

You can make a financial donation to enhance the summer staff stipend by donating online at www.camphebron.org/ donate, or complete and mail the form to the right and send back to Camp Hebron by July 1. This helps us better administer the program in a timely fashion. Donations will be accepted for the fund until September 1. If received after that date, they will go to the General Fund.
