While this printable was created to supplement the Jitney's Journeys 2017 Agenda, we encourage anyone and everyone to use this as a resource for scripture memory. Format

While you are free to use this printable however you'd like, here's what we had in mind when designing it: Each weekly verse begins on a Monday; therefore, week I begins on January 2. Overall, this resource was designed to help you dive into scripture. Don't stop at memorizing the verses; meditate on them and ask God to speak to you through them. Seek opportunities to encourage other believers throughout the week by speaking the truths you're learning. Each verse is taken from the ESV unless otherwise noted.
