The North Fork School offers full-year English, History, and Mathematics courses for Middle and High School students. As one semester is not adequate time to prepare students for college-preparatory work, The North Fork School does not offer semester-only course options.

All North Fork School classes comprise mixed grade levels. Students are placed according to their academic needs, not according to age or class requirements.
