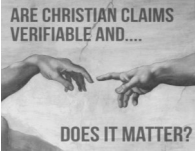

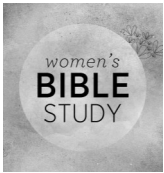
HISTORY STUDY GROUP
