ANALYSIS:

Salinas City Elementary School District Board Policy #5117 states:

“The Governing Board recognizes that students who reside in one District may choose to attend school in another District and that such choices are made for a variety of reasons. The Board desires to communicate with parents/guardians and students regarding the educational programs and services that are available.”

The Human Resources Department processes hundreds of interdistrict transfers annually.

FISCAL IMPACT:

A child who attends every one of the 180 days, brings the District approximately \$9,522.38 in Base and LCAP dollars.

PROGRAM IMPACT:

Upon meeting the interdistrict criteria, Salinas City Elementary School District parents and parents from outside the district have the option of attending an alternative school district.
