*Maresh Vineyard Pinot Noir*

The first of the heralded 2012 vintage is here. We previewed this as a Featured Wine at the International Pinot Noir Celebration (IPNC) and have received numerous inquiries of when it would be available. Here it is, available to Wine and Estate Club members first and to others as available. Last year, Stephen Tanzer rated a prior vintage a 92. Maresh Vineyard has produced legendary Pinot Noir for more than forty years after being planted by Jim Maresh in the Dundee Hills on lava soil.

**Dad:** Cherry jam on fresh baked bread. Mushroom, saline and savory. Smooth and long finish. Wow.

**Fille:** This wine reminds me of Penelope Cruz- sexy, voluptuous, and commands your attention. The smooth mouthfeel is round and complex. The cherry flavor is accented by earthy and savory characteristics and a touch of sandalwood. It would pair beautifully with pork tenderloin and mushroom risotto.
