*Deux Vert Vineyard Pinot Noir*

We held back the cool climate 2011 Deux Vert Vineyard Pinot Noir to give it time to soften, and are now pleased to be releasing it. Deux Vert Vineyard, owned by Mike and Patty Green (get it- "Two Greens?"), is where our Viognier comes from in the Yamhill-Carlton viticultural area. The low-yielding Wadenswil, 113, and 114 pinot noir clones from this vineyard are located in a warm block at about 300-390' elevation. This wine received a 92 by *Vinous*, formerly Tanzer's *International Wine Cellar*.

**Dad:** Captivating aroma of cherries, root beer and lilac. Taste of cherries, cranberries and five spice. Very long finish. Delicate. Drink 2018-2025.

**Fille:** The 2011 Deux Vert has a soft elegance of a cashmere sweater, characterized by its delicate and lovely aroma, bright balance, and long finish. Its bright profile and acidity make it a lovely dinner accompaniment and we enjoyed it with pork accented by spice and mushrooms.
