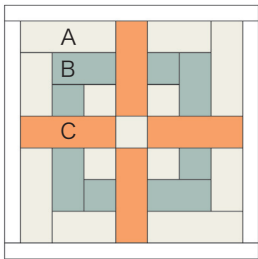


# Sewcial Bee Sampler

## #11 FOUR SQUARE



### Material List

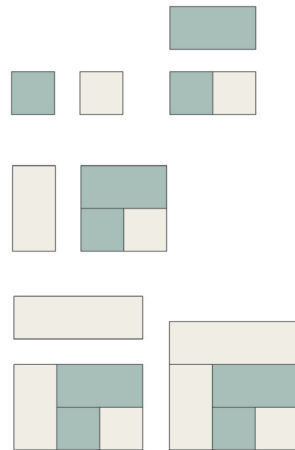
- (4) 2" x 5" strips, (4) 2" x 3-1/2" rectangles, and (5) 2" squares fabric A
- (4) 2" x 3-1/2" rectangles and (4) 2" squares fabric B
- (4) 2" x 5" strips fabric C
- (2) 1-1/4" x 11" strips and (2) 1-1/4" x 12-1/2" strips for frames

Read through all instructions before beginning. Remove selvages. Sew pieces right sides together and use a 1/4" seam throughout unless otherwise stated.

### Block Assembly

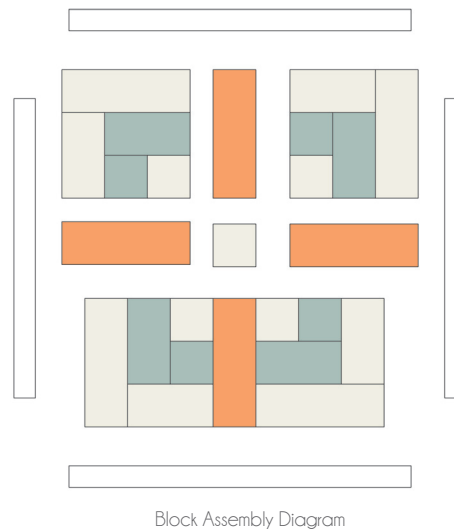
1. Noting placement, sew (1) 2"

fabric A square to (1) 2" fabric B square. With the fabric B square on the left, sew (1) 2" x 3-1/2" fabric A rectangle to the top of the pieced section. Sew (1) 2" x 3-1/2" fabric A rectangle to the left side of the pieced section. Sew (1) 2" x 5" fabric A strip to the top of the section to make one unit. Make a total of 4 units in the same manner.



2. Referring to the Block Assembly Diagram, sew (1) 2" x 5" fabric C strip between 2 units to make row A. Make a total of 2 A rows.

3. Sew (1) 2" fabric A square between (2) 2" x 5" fabric C strips to make row B.
4. Join the rows to make the block.
5. Stitch the (2) 1-1/4" x 11" framing strips to opposite sides of the block. Stitch the (2) 1-1/4" x 12-1/2" framing strips to the remaining sides of the block.



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
