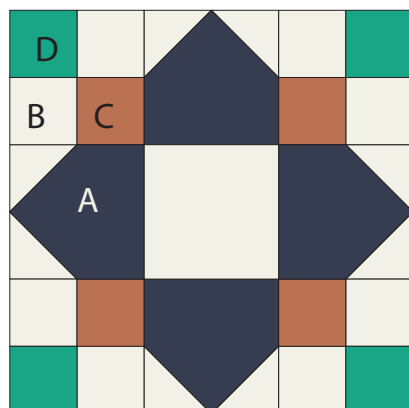


Kitty-Corner



CUT

•Fabric A

» Four 4- $\frac{3}{4}$ " squares

•Fabric B

- » One 4- $\frac{1}{2}$ " square
- » Eight 2- $\frac{3}{4}$ " squares
- » Eight 2- $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

•Fabric C

» Four 2- $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

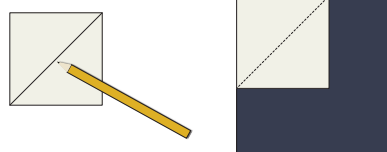
•Fabric D

» Four 2- $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares

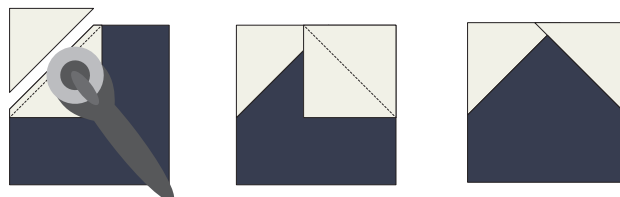
Read through all instructions before beginning. Remove selvages. Cut pieces exactly as listed in instructions. Sew pieces right sides together and use an accurate $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.

Quick-Corner Units

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of each 2- $\frac{3}{4}$ " fabric B square. Noting orientation of the drawn line, place a marked square right sides together on a corner of a 4- $\frac{3}{4}$ " fabric A square.

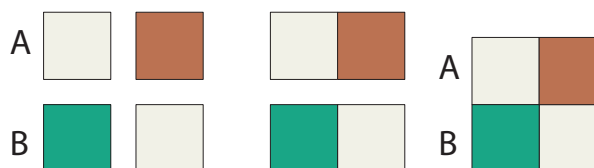


2. Sew on the line. Trim $\frac{1}{4}$ " past the stitch line. Press corner open. Noting orientation of drawn line, repeat on the other corner as shown to make a Quick-Corner unit. Trim unit to 4- $\frac{1}{2}$ " square, leaving a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance on each side. Make a total of four Quick-Corner units.



Four-Patch Units

1. Noting placement, sew two 2- $\frac{1}{2}$ " fabric B squares, one 2- $\frac{1}{2}$ " fabric C square, and one 2- $\frac{1}{2}$ " fabric D square into two rows of two squares each. Join rows to make a Four-Patch unit that measures 4- $\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Make a total of four Four-Patch units.



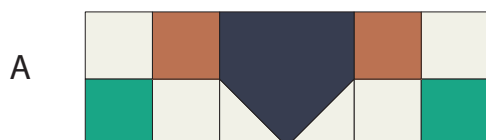
BLOCK ASSEMBLY

1. Referring to the Block Assembly Diagram on page 2 and noting placement and orientation, sew one Quick-Corner unit between two Four-Patch units to make row A. Make a total of two A rows.

2. Sew the 4- $\frac{1}{2}$ " fabric B square between two Quick-Corner units to make a B row.

3. Join the rows to make a block. Trim to 12- $\frac{1}{2}$ " square.
