In addition, there is limited space to maneuver around the back wall of the sanctuary in the two sections nearest to the Welcome Center. This week both of these problems will be addressed by rearranging the two back pews in each of these sections to effectively shorten each pew approximately 2 feet.

In addition, a laminated handicap placard will be placed on pews in the 4 locations where it will be easiest for a wheelchair to sit beside the end of a pew. This will reserve one spot for a family member or a caregiver to sit next to each of these locations. Thank you for honoring these "reserved" markers so that folks with special needs can know that they are welcome in our midst!
