

Instructions for Spelling Bee Choreography



Set up the classroom to look like the diagram above.

Next, organize the class into teams of two (counting method), leaving one person to proctor the spelling bee and read the words aloud, and one person to keep time.

Separate the teammates into two rows on either side of the room. Put original score on the table along with all of the additional score instruction variables. After the room is setup according to the visual key, the spelling will begin.

First, the players on the north side of the room will be spellers, each player will get one word to spell, they have 45 seconds to spell the word. They will hear the word, a definition, and a repeat of the word. If they get it right, their teammate will have 30 seconds to approach the score and add a new instruction to the score on the table. If the speller gets the word wrong, the teammate will have to take away a piece of the preexisting score. The teammate can add or subtract from anywhere in the score.

When the last person on the north side of the room has had a chance to spell, the roles will reverse. Whichever team gets the most words right during the bee will have their names credited first in the collaboration description that goes with the dance video. Everyone who participates will be included as collaborators and credited as choreographers. If every team gets the same amount of words right, the list of collaborators will be in alphabetical order.
