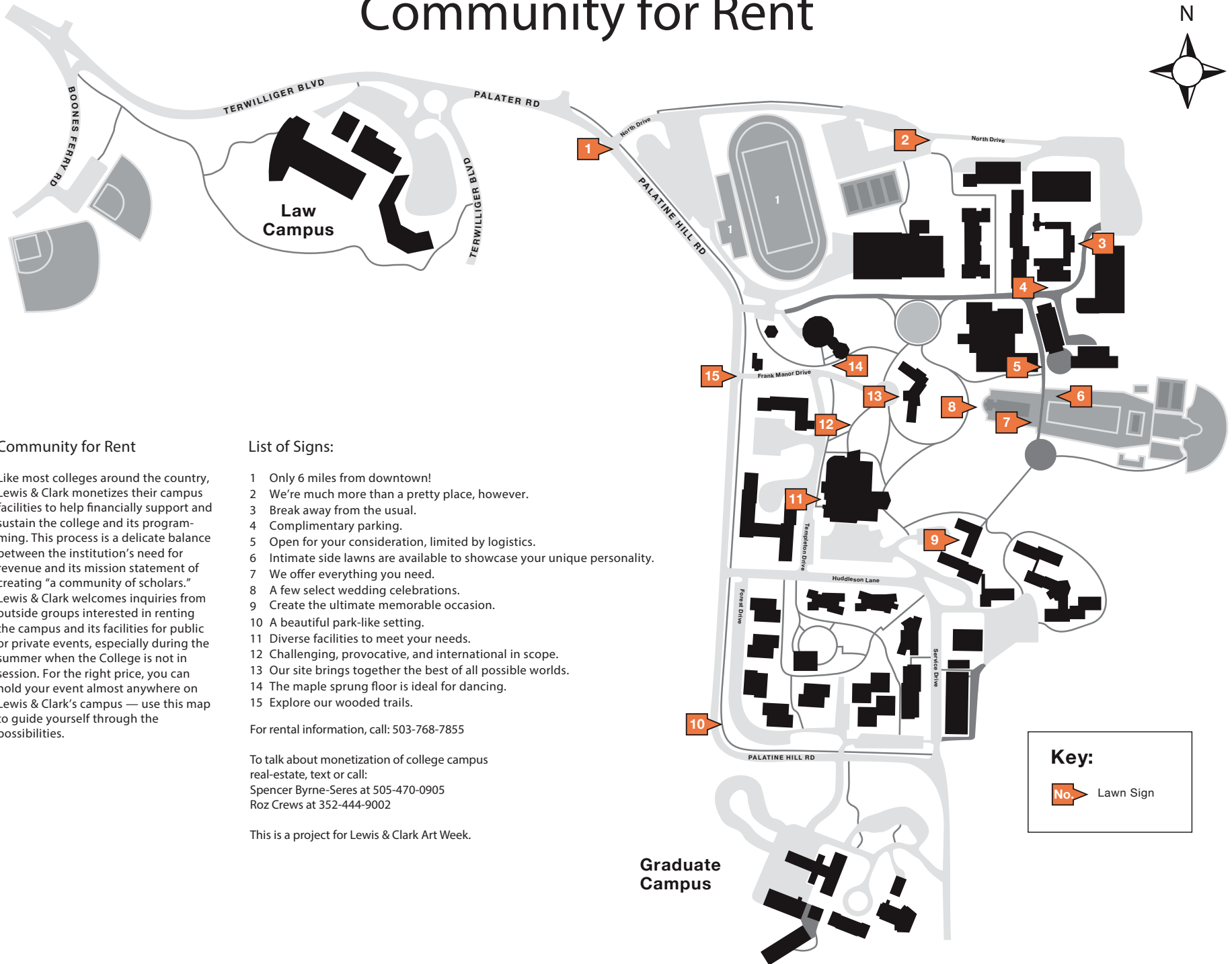


# Community for Rent
