## SPROAT LAKE LANDING

Middle of Vancouver Island



Missing for almost half a century, the iconic Joe Drinkwater tugboat returned to Sproat Lake. In the mid 1940's the Joe Drinkwater III, arrived from Great Central Lake to Sproat Lake. During its almost 30 year stay, the famous tugboat was a signature trademark of a vibrant and flourishing forestry industry; hauling building materials, towing log flows, and delivering fresh food and spirits to both residents and businesses around Sproat Lake.

The original Joe Drinkwater Tugboat dates back over a century ago, to 1899. The tugboat was named after Joseph Drinkwater, a prospector and trapper who pioneered much of the gold prospecting activity. Joe Drinkwater discovered the tallest vertical falls in Canada (440m /1443 ft) and named them after his wife Della. Accessible only by hiking trails, Della falls is approximately 30 kms from Sproat Lake.

Sproat Lake Landing is proud to continue the tradition with Drinkwaters Restaurant and the launch of the Joe Drinkwater IV tugboat, signifying the bounty and importance of tourism to Sproat Lake and the Alberni Valley.
