PRINTMAKER

Montgomery is a Tasmanian born artist and printmaker living in Sydney.

Sarah has been creating since her early school years where she discovered her love of drawing could be developed into the painterly, mark making expression of printmaking.

The smooth tones of light and dark and scratched up surfaces were always a focus as she experimented with inks, etching and handmade papers. The Edges of artworks became saturated with colour and overprinted with pattern. Thoughts and observations were scored into copper plates. An open-ended narrative of our human connection to the environment was expressed. This new series of prints, depicts blurred blues in contrast with white clouds and soft spaces, floating lands and thoughts. These dreamlike places allow personal interpretation.

Journal entry:

"The ink glides smoothly across the plate, the contours and hollows softened with mustard hues, and steely blue- greys. The drawings overlap and many lines give shape to a detailed printing plate, a new story begins..."
