2018 Marketplace Registration Form

Expo Regulations:

1. Table location will be assigned after payment has been received, and is subject to change. Maximum 2 tables per vendor.
2. Exhibitors will be provided with an 8' skirted table. Vendors may bring their own chair. Any additional materials should be stored under your table.
3. Pop-up displays should go behind your table. A place to hang/drape a banner will not be provided. No tents allowed.
4. Exhibitors will be provided with one free pass to the Expo to staff their table. Additional passes can be purchased for \$10.
5. All exhibitors must provide a certificate of liability insurance for \$1,000,000 with the event organizer, the Saskatchewan Environmental Society, listed as additional insured.
6. Exhibitors are responsible for the security of their own booths at the Expo.
7. Exhibitors are discouraged from distributing excessive promotional materials. Exhibitors are encouraged to print promotional materials on FSC-certified paper and/or 100% post-consumer recycled paper.
8. Food & Beverage sample containers must be certified compostable.

I understand my responsibilities as an Exhibitor and agree to abide by the Expo Regulations as listed below as well as any federal, provincial and municipal regulations that may apply.

I acknowledge that the aim of the Saskatchewan Living Green Expo is to promote sustainable living. Exhibits which do not support this goal may be denied at the discretion of the Saskatchewan Living Green Expo.
