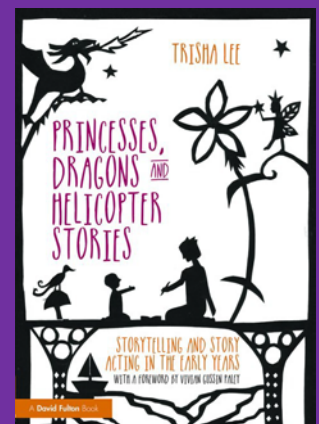
Why choose Helicopter Stories?
