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The Play Worker passes the worksheet to player one. On the YOUR EMOTIONAL STATUS chart on the left, player one evaluates their emotional status and uses the pen to fill in the one circle that best describes it. The worksheet is passed to player two.

On the YOUR EMOTIONAL STATUS chart on the right, player two evaluates their emotional status and uses the pen to fill in the one circle that best describes it. On the THEIR PHYSICAL APPEARANCE chart on the right, player two evaluates the physical appearance of player one and uses the pen to fill in the one circle that best describes it. The worksheet is passed back to player one.

On the THEIR PHYSICAL APPEARANCE chart on the left, player one evaluates the physical appearance of player two and uses the pen to fill in the one circle that best describes it. The worksheet and pen are passed back to the Play Worker and you are ready to begin.

## GAME PLAY

The first round begins with the Play Worker generating the first response. Without letting either player see the word or words, the Play Worker writes  $x$  and  $y$  on the left-hand column. Both players are ready, both players write their responses that whatever they think the other player will write. The responses starting are the same. The responses on the right-hand column are the responses. Responses are logged on the worksheet.

Round two begins with the Play Worker passing the worksheet between  $x$  and  $y$ . The variables generated are the same. The players keep writing their responses towards the center of their chalkboard. The responses are logged on the worksheet. Erase the responses from a round.
