In 1908, a cooperative was formed by 30 wine growers in Gries to promote local wines. Another cooperative was established in 1930 by 18 wine growers near S. Maddalena. Today, Kellerei Bozen has 224 families as members focusing on near-natural methods and sustainable vineyard management with care for soils and vines.

CLAIM TO FAME

Perl, a balanced bottle, shows a little skin with savory, intense, and complex qualities underlying a ripe, smooth surface; it's our favorite. Dark garnet in color with rose petals and cocoa bean aromatics, Perl is tempting and sumptuous from start to finish. Velvety tannins and light minerals interplay on the palate, making this bottling a pleasure from start to finish. Single Vineyard.
