The Rose-Anne Kelso Commemorative Award

In memory of Rose-Anne Kelso, this award was created by Life Sciences Queensland Limited (LSQ) to recognise an individual female's endeavours, passion and dedication to the health and life sciences industry.



Rose-Anne was committed to fostering better health outcomes for Queenslanders. Originally a physiotherapist, Rose served as the president of the boards of Diabetes Australia Queensland and Australia Physiotherapy Association Queensland. In addition to this she sat on a number of other boards in the health and business industries including Implicit Bioscience.

Rose was a beloved mother, wife, sister and colleague. She believed in supporting and encouraging the women around her to reach their potential. Rose travelled extensively (often with her family) in order to grow and share her knowledge.

The Award will assist an individual with enhancing their objectives, outcomes and opportunities within the health and life sciences industry, through the provision of AU\$3000 towards flights and travel expenses to attend an appropriate international meeting (as mutually agreed), and recognition among the media, domestic and international business leaders, investors and the broader community.

Application process

- Applicants must provide up to 150 words outlining their work in health and biomedical innovation, the impact of their work, and how winning the prize will assist with their future endeavours (they should also identify the conference they would seek to attend with the prize money).
- Submissions will be reviewed by a committee including representatives from the Award Sponsor Stockwell and LSQ.
- The committee's decision is final.
- The committee reserves the right not to award the prize if it is deemed that no submission is meritorious of the award.
- The Award will be announced at GENE 2017, 26 October 2018.
- Applications must be received by COB Friday 14 September 2018.
- Shortlisted applicants will be interviewed from 8, 9, 10 October 2018.

Eligibility Criteria

- Applicants must be a passionate female looking to take their career to the next level.
- Applicants must be an employee of, or working for an LSQ Member organisation in any area of health and biomedical innovation to be eligible to apply for the prize.
- Individuals with aspirations towards Directorship, mentorship and learning and sharing their knowledge will be highly regarded.
