A Guardian Scholarship provides up to \$8,000 a year in scholarship funds intended for motivated young adults to help fund a college education in Iowa. Guardian Scholarships are intended for students who have spent time in foster care in Iowa between the ages of 14-18. Other students who live in special circumstances without the support of parents or close family may also be considered at the discretion of the scholarship review committee. Students must earn a high school diploma with a 2.3 grade-point average or be in the process of pursuing a post-secondary degree in good standing. In order to receive the scholarship students must be attending school full-time and in good standing. Involvement in one or more extra-curricular sport or activity will also be favorably considered.
