

**MANA CONTEMPORARY PRESENTS A PREVIEW OF ARTISTIC FURNITURE
AND BRONZE SCULPTURE BY ILANA GOOR**



JERSEY CITY, NJ, September 18, 2013—Mana Contemporary will unveil its new Department of Decorative Art and Design with preview new artistic furniture and bronze sculpture by Ilana Goor in its new second floor gallery. The new series by Goor, which she describes as “furniture which appears as machines without engines” includes contemporary furniture and lighting items which are both artistic and functional, employing materials such as iron, wood, leather, fabric, glass and transparent plastic. Goor, born in Tiberias, Israel, developed her artistic techniques on her own from an early age, when she used various parts to create small statues. Her works encompass sculptures, furniture, judaica, lighting fixtures, jewelry and fashion items which are displayed in well known galleries worldwide and are distinguished by their powerful, dominant presence. Her works have been exhibited at the California Museum of Science and Industry in Los Angeles, the Tel Aviv Museum of Art, the Museum of 20th Century Art in Vienna, and more.

Ilana Goor: New Limited Edition of Artistic Furniture and Bronze Sculpture will open as a complete exhibition on January 12, 2014.
