The mission of the Foundations Program is to increase reading literacy and teach biblical truths to our K-2nd grade Forerunners by meeting together in a safe and engaging after-school program for 3 hours every Monday through Friday.

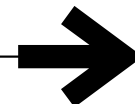

The mission of the Development Program is to practice godly character traits and teach life skills to our 7th-8th grade Forerunners by meeting together for 2 ½ hours every Monday through Friday in our after-school program.

MENTORING PROGRAM

MENTORING PROGRAM

The mission of our Mentoring Program is to build trusting relationships between Forerunner and mentor by meeting biweekly to build a relationship that points toward Jesus Christ and helps fulfill potential.

Forerunners in the Mentoring Program include all students in after-school programs and three off-campus students.

INPUTS

\$40,000 Mentoring budget
(includes staff salary)

2 dedicated staff

35 mentor volunteers

Forerunner Office lobby space

19 background checks
completed

ACTIVITIES

1 hour every two weeks
spent training mentors

1 hour every two weeks
spent between Forerunner
and mentor at After School
Program

1-2 hours of time every
two weeks spent between
Forerunner, family, and
mentor outside of
Forerunner-sponsored
events

2 hours of time every
month spent between
Forerunner, family, and
mentor at Forerunner
Family Dinner events

OUTPUTS

31 Forerunners paired with
a mentor for a long-term
relationship

90% of mentors visit their
Forerunner outside of
program every other week in
an intentional mentoring
session

50% of mentors visit their
Forerunner once a week at
the after-school program

INTERMEDIATE OUTCOMES

87.5% of Forerunners feel
supported by their mentor

75% of Forerunners have
been taught about a
relationship with Jesus by
their mentor

56.3% of Forerunners feel
comfortable approaching
their mentor with questions
about faith and life

75% of Forerunners say they
would turn to their mentor in
a time of crisis or decision

MOMS PROGRAM

MOMS PROGRAM

The mission of the Moms Ministry is to increase relationship and support for the single moms of our Forerunners by meeting together every month and maintaining biweekly communication between a Forerunner mom and a Forerunner volunteer in our community.

Moms with children in our after-school or mentoring programs.

INPUTS

\$13,500 Moms Ministry budget
1 dedicated staff
23 volunteers
3 monthly childcare volunteers
Forerunner office lobby space

ACTIVITIES

1.5 hour Moms event every month

- 1 hour of dinner and fellowship every month
- 30 minutes of Bible study discussion every other month
- 30 minutes of team building activity every other month

1.5 hours of free childcare provided every month for each mom

OUTPUTS

28 single moms served monthly

12 gospel presentations per year

13.5 hours of free childcare offered to each mom per year

18 free meals offered to each mom per year

18 free meals given to each child

INTERMEDIATE OUTCOMES

100% of moms say they see a positive change in their relationship with their son because of Forerunner

45.5% of moms are now connected to a local church

100% feel supported by the resources and relationships Forerunner provides

100% of moms feel like part of a safe community due to Forerunner relationships

100% of moms would recommend Forerunner to a friend

LONG-TERM OUTCOMES

Our goal is that 80% of our Forerunner moms attend church weekly, feel connected to a supportive community, and are equipped to lead their families to trust and follow Christ.

Our Logic Models show how we plan to reach this goal through each of our programs.
