Most Needed Items:

- Adult-sized hats, gloves and mittens (waterproof and durable materials preferred)
- Adult-sized tall socks (thicker material preferred)
- Adult-sized coats and snow pants (waterproof and durable materials preferred)
- Twin-sized or larger blankets (cotton and fleece preferred)
- Sleeping bags
- Emergency thermal blankets

New and gently used items are appreciated. Please ensure that used items are in good condition, with working zippers and fasteners. While knitted and crocheted items are lovely, they do not provide the necessary warmth and durability that our neighbors living outside require.
