

**Southeast Gateway Area Assembly
Broadway Christian Church
October 24, 2015**

Moderator KJ Reynolds called the meeting to order.

The agenda was accepted unanimously based on a motion by David Woodard, seconded by John Harwell.

A quorum was declared as thirty-seven voters were present, and thirty-four required.

The minutes of the April 18, 2015 were accepted unanimously based on a motion by Tom Wood, seconded by Howard Goodrich.

The moderator read the Plan and Agreement of Merger, which had been available to all for months prior to the meeting. James Brooks moved to approve it and Tom Wood seconded that motion. After some very brief discussion, the motion passed unanimously.

David Woodard explained and led the Assembly in SEGA's Last Will and Testament.

The meeting was adjourned based on a motion by Dawna Watkins, seconded by Devoree Crist.
