The annual summer Festival, which just celebrated its 40th anniversary, has long-held a tradition of hosting its' annual event at one of the four DOC affiliated colleges in the Mid-America Region. The youth also manage to fit in a few hours of mission and service work, as well as a presentation at their host church's worship service during these four meeting weekends.

CRY Festival participants are offered an experience unlike anything else in the Mid-America Region. In addition to fun, free time, and time spent getting to meet and know one another, participants engage in small group discussions, interactive and engaging workshops, mission and service projects, leadership and development opportunities, meditation and prayer, and more. All participants are awarded a certificate of completion, confirming their four days spent engaging in leadership and management development, service and spiritual growth.

The theme for CRY 2018 is 'Be the rEVOLution' based on Proverbs 10:12 "Hate stirs up conflict, but love covers all offenses." The keynote speaker is the Rev. Ayanna Johnson Watkins; Rev. Watkins come to CRY from Memphis, TN where she is currently the Director of the NBA incubate Initiative with the greater Christian Church DOC. The Festival will also offer workshops on relevant topics, such as sacred conversations on race and racism, world religions, sexual integrity, social justice and activism, table talk on hot topics, Biblical interpretation, planning and leading worship, dealing with teen drama, and more.
