Colorful Minds: What Mental Health Means to Me is a group, non-juried exhibit open to all art mediums.

Colorful Minds Art Exhibit goal is to bring public awareness to the stigma of mental illness through art. Many people have a preconceived notion of what mental illness looks, and this exhibit seeks to challenge that perception. Cirrus House, Inc. focuses on providing quality of life and independence for people living with mental illness in the Nebraska Panhandle through opportunities for advocacy, housing, employment, education and a peer supported community where members can find belonging and purpose.

The exhibit will open Thursday, June 29, with an opening reception on Thursday, July 6 from 5:00 to 7:00 p.m. and will continue in the Bronson gallery through August 27, 2017. The Colorful Minds Art Exhibit is an open exhibit. We will include as much artwork as our gallery space is able to accommodate. There is a limit of **2 entries** per artist.

eligibility

Open to youth and adult artists of all ages. Artists must be able to deliver their artwork and completed entry form to Cirrus House by Monday, June 19. Cirrus House will deliver all artwork to WNAC on June 26, 2017. (WNAC is closed Mondays) Artists must also be able to remove their unsold artwork after the exhibit has closed. Any artwork left more than 60 days after the show ends will become property of WNAC.

artwork requirements

Open to all original artwork dealing with the theme. (Limit: two entries per artist.) **2-D work must meet framing requirements outlined within this entry form** and must not exceed 4' (including frame) in any direction. 3-D work must fit through a standard doorway and weigh less than 75 lbs. All artwork in the exhibition must be identified with **two identification tags (one on the front, one on the back)** with the following information: artist, title, medium (please be as specific as possible with all media used), year completed, and price (or nfs). Artwork must not have shown previously in our gallery. All artwork in the Colorful Minds exhibit must remain in the Bronson gallery throughout the exhibit (June 29 – August 27, 2017). Artwork must be picked up by Cirrus House on Monday, Aug. 28, 2017, between 9:00 –11:00 a.m.. Any artwork left more than 60 days after the show ends will become property of WNAC.

framing requirements

WE WILL ACCEPT: wire back, centered saw tooth, centered hole.

WE DO NOT ACCEPT: NO way to hang, any double saw tooth or double hole, taped, glued, stapled wire or string. ABSOLUTELY NO EASEL BACKS WILL BE ACCEPTED!

Artwork that does not meet the requirements within this prospectus will not be accepted.
