2018 Scholarship - guidelines

deadline

APPLICATIONS POSTMARKED ON OR BEFORE: Monday, April 2, 2018. The decision of the NPVAG will be final and notification to the winner will be made on or before Friday, April 27, 2018.

eligibility

The North Platte Valley Artist Guild scholarship is to be used only by high school seniors or current junior college students planning to study art at a higher college in the near future. The applicant must be a resident of western Nebraska or eastern Wyoming. The scholarship may be used at any junior college, four-year college, university or trade school with an accredited art department. **Scholarship winners from previous years are not eligible to re-apply.**

amount

The 2018 North Platte Valley Artist Guild scholarship is a total amount of five hundred dollars (\$500.00). The scholarship will be paid to the recipient upon proof of registration in any college accredited art course that is taken for credit. This proof must be sent within three (3) semesters of award notification date to receive the payment of the scholarship. Failure to do so is automatic termination of the organization's responsibility.

requirements

Your application package must contain the following:

- completed application form
- 5 examples of your recent artwork (recent examples of artwork may include any original or class-assigned artwork)
Images may be submitted in one of the following ways:
 - printed images or photographs (please no larger than 8.5x11")
 - a thumb drive with jpeg images (preferred)
 - a CD with jpeg images

Please include a reference page with information about each image including: title of artwork, medium, year completed, if it was a class assignment or your own inspiration, and any other information you feel would be important for the review committee to know about your artwork.
