We would like to help you get your digital purchases onto your iPhone or iPad devices. Here are a couple of options

Option 1 – Download files to your Laptop/Desktop

1. Download your files

You must first download your purchased media onto your laptop or desktop. To do this...

- a) Visit whcc.net
- b) Online Store is found under “Resources”
- c) Select and complete the digital download purchase
- d) Click on the link from the web browser or your email to download your file to your laptop or desktop.

2. Move your files into iTunes

- a) Open the iTunes app on your desktop or laptop.
- b) Next, find your files within your downloads folder.
- c) Drag and drop your files into iTunes.

3. Sync with your device

- a) Sync the data on iTunes on your computer with your iPhone or iPad.

Option 2 – Download files to your Dropbox Account in your iPhone or iPad

Note: This option will work for your iPhone or iPad device if you have an existing Dropbox account. You must also make sure that you have enough space to store your digital downloads. 1. Download & Login to Dropbox

- a) Download the Dropbox app from the Apple App Store
- b) Login to Dropbox – or sign up for a free account

2. Download your files

Download your purchased media onto your iPhone or iPad.

- a) Visit whcc.net
- b) Online Store is found under “Resources”
- c) Select and complete the digital download purchase
- d) Copy and paste the download link to a new browser tab

3. Save to Dropbox

- a) After pasting the link to a NEW browser tab, load the page by pressing “Go” or “Enter” on the keyboard
- b) Click on the Arrow option on the top right (iPhone only)
- c) Select the option “Save to my Dropbox”
 - a. If you are not signed in, you may have to sign in again
- d) File should start to download to your Dropbox Account

Note: This processes is a little bit different for everyone depending on your iPhone operating system.
