PORTLAND—Attorney General Ellen Rosenblum will join the Consumer Protection Financial Bureau (CFPB) this Wednesday, April 20, 2016 to launch the CFPB's *Managing Someone Else's Money* Oregon-specific guides. The event, which is co-hosted by the CFPB and the Oregon Department of Justice, will release the Oregon guides for financial caregivers. The guides are designed to educate Oregonians and other caregivers on how to better manage finances for older Oregonians who need help.
