

CHRIS M. GREEN is a Brooklyn-based designer, director, and performer. His theatrical and installation works have been presented over the past 20 years nationally and internationally in venues including Lincoln Center, New York City Center, St. Anne's Warehouse, Goethe Institute (Delhi), National Geographic Museum, La Jolla Playhouse, Teatro del Lago (Chile), and BAM Harvey among others. Honors include Creative Capital (2009), MacDowell Fellowship (2012), and an LMCC Process Space Grant (2013). Since 2005, his design studio Chris Green Kinetics has received awards of excellence from the American Association of Museums, TEA, and a Regional Design Award from AIA. Recent projects include 'Firebird' with ten puppeteers and full orchestra, 'Hagoromo', a puppetry and dance collaboration with David Michalek, David Neumann, and Wendy Whelan, and 'This Is Hunger', a multi-media installation about hunger in America traveling across the country in an expanding tractor-trailer. Currently, Green is developing the material-musical 'American Weather' through a HERE Artist Residency for premiere in 2018, NYC.
