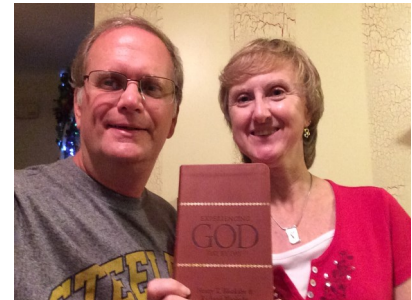
### Extra Ordinary Give 2016
