Sermon Notes | Strong Church

EPHESIANS 3:14-21

For this reason I bow my knees before the Father, ¹⁵from whom every family in heaven and on earth is named, 16that according to the riches of his glory he may grant you to be strengthened with power through his Spirit in your inner being, ¹⁷so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith-that you, being rooted and grounded in love, 18 may have strength to comprehend with all the saints what is the breadth and length and height and depth. ¹⁹and to know the love of Christ that surpasses knowledge, that you may be filled with all the fullness of God. ²⁰Now to him who is able to do far more abundantly than all that we ask or think, according to the power at work within us, 21 to him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus throughout all generations, forever and ever. Amen.

JUDE 1:3; 12-13

³Beloved, although I was very eager to write to you about our common salvation, I found it necessary to write appealing to you to contend for the faith that was once for all delivered to the saints. ¹²These are hidden reefs at your love feasts, as they feast with you without fear, shepherds feeding themselves; waterless clouds, swept along by winds; fruitless trees in late autumn, twice dead, uprooted; 13 wild waves of the sea, casting up the foam of their own shame; wandering stars, for whom the gloom of utter darkness has been reserved forever.

This week, we explored the urgent need for strong churches, beginning with our own and extending our support to others.

First, there is plenty of Biblical support for strong churches. Colossians 2:6-8, "Therefore, as you received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in him, ⁷rooted and built up in him and established in the faith, just as you were taught, abounding in thanksgiving. ⁸See to it that no one takes you captive by philosophy and empty deceit, according to human tradition, according to the elemental spirits of the world, and not according to Christ." See also Jude 3 and 12.

Secondly, there is historical support. The great 19th-century preacher Charles Spurgeon warned,

"They are going to regenerate the world by Democratic Socialism, and set up a kingdom for Christ without the new birth or the pardon of sin...To me it seems a tangle of everchanging dreams. It is, by the confession of its inventors, the outcome of the period-the monstrous birth of a boasted "progress"--the scum from the cauldron of conceit. It has not been given by the infallible revelation of God-it does not pretend to have been. It is not divine-it has no inspired Scripture at its back. It is, when it touches the Cross, an enemy! When it speaks of Him who died thereon, it is a deceitful friend. Many are its sneers at the truth of substitution-it is irate at the mention of the precious blood. Many a pulpit, where Christ was once lifted high in all the glory of His atoning death, is now profaned by those who laugh at justification by faith. In fact, men are now not to be saved by faith but by doubt. Those who love the Church of God feel heavy at heart because the teachers of the people cause them to err."

How does the Church respond to Romans 8 faith? We become the church that Jesus came to plant.

Five Attributes of a Strong Church:

1: Strong churches have powerful services/gatherings.

At their best when grounded in truth, accessible, and joyful.

- Environment: Smiling faces; Holy Spirit is welcome and at work.
- Worship: Jesus-centered, theologically rich, engaging.
- Teaching: Expository –a mix of verse-by-verse and topical.
- Kids: Enjoy church, make friends, love Jesus.
 *Quick Note: We had 46 kids in elementary last week, and

211 kids total. Starting next week: 1st-4th and 5th-8th.
