

# Psychology Transfer Pathway (AA to BA)

for Ohio Community College students  
transferring to Ohio Wesleyan University



November 2022

This document outlines the [Ohio Guaranteed Transfer Pathway \(OGTP\) in Psychology](#) that has been designed to provide clarity and consistency for college courses transferring between Ohio 2-year and 4-year public institutions.

This same transfer pathway in Psychology is now approved for students transferring to Ohio Wesleyan University, through a partnership between 11 Ohio community colleges and 14 private colleges called the [Ohio Consortium for Transfer Pathways to the Liberal Arts](#), and whose faculty and administration have collaborated to expand access and credit clarity for students transferring with an associate's degree from an Ohio community college to an Ohio private college or university.

Pages 1 & 2 of this document outline **community college courses that are approved statewide** for transfer credit for the AA to BA degree in psychology at an approved 4-year institution. Pages 3-4 show the AS to BS degree. Pages 5-7 show how these courses transfer to Ohio Wesleyan University to meet bachelor degree requirements.

Students with plans of pursuing a pre-professional track such as pre-medicine or graduate studies in the future should work closely with their academic advisor and receiving institution starting in the first year of their program in order to adequately prepare themselves for those types of tracks.

## How Psychology Pathway Courses Transfer to Ohio Wesleyan University

A student transferring to Ohio Wesleyan University with the associate of arts degree and psychology transfer pathway completed will receive maximum credit, placing them at or near junior standing with introductory coursework in the psychology major completed. Most or all of the Ohio Wesleyan University general education requirements can be completed as part of the associate degree, through planning with a transfer advisor. Students interested in transferring to Ohio Wesleyan University should meet with an admission counselor regarding optimal course selection and admission requirements.

The following table outlines how transfer credits from the psychology transfer pathway and associate's degree will be applied to the Bachelor of Arts in Psychology degree at Ohio Wesleyan University.

- a) At Ohio Wesleyan University all students must complete one course that is designated as a “diversity” course (i.e., DIV) and three courses that are designated “writing” courses (i.e., WRI). These are not separate courses, but rather courses that have a designation as DIV or WRI.
- b) Note, Ohio Wesleyan University utilizes a credit system whereby most traditional classes count for 1.0 credits. This is usually equivalent to 3.0 credit hours for other universities. Hence, a class taken elsewhere for 3.0 credits is generally equivalent to 1.0 credits at Ohio Wesleyan University. However, the exact transfer of credit may equal less than 1.0 (e.g., a 3.0 credit class often transfers in to Ohio Wesleyan University as 0.81 credits). Students are strongly encouraged to discuss the exact credit hours transfer amounts with an admissions counselor before enrolling.

OWU will institute new General Education requirements in Fall 2023 that differ from the current institutional requirements. Students should talk with an OWU transfer advisor about course selection.
