The money donated by parishioners was used to purchase a Rock n Play Sleeper, swaddle blankets, a sleep sack, some clothes, a baby bathtub, hooded towel, washcloths, and bath products. The remaining funds will be used to purchase whatever the family thinks they still need. Lin and Aa Ka were very appreciative and kept thanking everyone at the shower for their generosity.
