One of our refugee moms needs a job!! We have been friends with her and her two children for a couple of years and can attest to her positive and friendly attitude and excellent work ethic.

- She has worked at a Holiday Inn, WeWork and JLL, helping with commercial cleaning and various hospitality-related functions.
- She is friendly, attentive to details and definitely a hard worker.
- She speaks Hindi, Malay and Burmese putting most of us volunteers to shame—and can understand and respond in English if it is spoken slowly.
- She is the primary (and only) breadwinner in her family, having two kids age 11 and 17 and has now been out of work for a number of months. But is not on assistance.
- Because she is the sole caretaker of the family, she needs a 9-5 job; late night/early morning/ weekend shifts won't work for this single mom.
