A pristine white page filled with crisp black lines and a brand new box of crayons can be a magical thing. A coloring book is an open ended question, the frame work has been established but the direction that it takes is up to the crayons. A green frog is simply a frog but a purple frog can be something else entirely. It makes sense that after years of sharpening my craft as an illustrator, I should return to this, a coloring book. In my new coloring book you will find a menagerie of creatures from frogs and owls to bugs, fish, flowers and geometry. Nature presents the most incredible study of shapes. Using wildlife as a foundation, I can create an image that is instantly familiar while stretching the boundaries of what the subject is composed of. A frenzy of paislies, swirls and stripes can create the silhouette of an owl. Leaves and dots can come together to form a rabbit crouching in a field of wild flowers. The possibilities are endless and it's that idea of reinvention that consumes my imagination.
The drawings collected here represent a history of my fabric designs, extracted from their infinite repeating loop and reduced to their most essential lines and shapes. ## FABRIC:

1 FAT QUARTER each of 18 prints

* FB1FQTP. 42015 Chipper FQ Bundle

1 STRAIGHT QUARTER (9" X WOF) each of 10 Solids

5/8 yard Corner triangles
2½ yards Wide Backing
$5 / 8$ yard Binding
78" x 78" Batting


ADDITIONALTOOLS:



scissors

$1 / 4$ inch foot

iron

thread

Note: The fabric requirements provide extra fabric for the prints to leave room for "fussy cutting"

## C U T TIN G

From each of the $\mathbf{1 0}$ solids cut the following:
(4) $73 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 73 / 4$ " for a total of 40 large squares
(5) $37 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 37 / 8^{" 1}$ Cut once diagonally, for a total of 100 small triangles

From each of the $\mathbf{1 8}$ prints cut the following:
(1) $127 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 127 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ for a total of 18 large squares

Cut once diagonally to create a total of 36 large triangles

GUT ONCE DIAGONALLY


From Corner Triangles fabric cut the following:
(2) $9^{1 / 2 "} \times 9^{1 / 2 "}$ cut once diagonally, for a total of 4 corner triangles
(1) $127 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 127 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ cut once diagonally, leaving one extra triangle

From the binding fabric cut:
for straight grain binding: (8) 42"
OR

for bias binding: a total of 320"

## B UILDINGTHEBLOCKS

- Use scant $1 / 4$ " seams throughout construction.
-Place all fabrics, blocks and rows right sides together then sew.
- Press all seams open unless otherwise noted.


## HALESQUARETRIANGLES (HST):

1. Select one solid $73 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 73 / 4^{4}$ square.
2. Draw a diagonal line, on the wrong side of the fabric, from the bottom left corner to the upper right corner.
3. Draw a second diagonal line, on the wrong side of the fabric from the bottom right corner to the upper left corner of the square to create an " $X$ ".
4. Place the drawn $73 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 73 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ square, right sides together, with a contrasting $73 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times$ $73 / 4$ " square.
5. Using the drawn line as a guide, sew a scant $1 / 4$ " to the left and a scant $1 / 4$ to the right of one diagonal line.
6. Using the drawn line as a guide, sew a scant $1 / 4^{\prime \prime}$ to the left and a scant $1 / 4$ " to the right of the second diagonal line.
7. Cut the sewn squares in half vertically then in half again horizontally creating four sets of squares measuring $37 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 37 / 8^{\prime \prime}$.
8. Cut on the diagonal line of each square set creating eight $31 / 2$ " Half Square

Triangles or one "HST" set. Press.
9. Repeat to create a total of 25 HST sets.

## ASSEMBLE THE BLOCK:

10. Arrange six of the HTS's from one set and four small triangles according to the diagram below. Press.


NOTE: Five of the blocks will be made up of miss-matched HST's pulled from the leftover HST's.
11. Sew one large Print triangle to the HST half block, with right sides together along the angled edge. Press.
12. Repeat steps 10 and 11 to create a total of 25 blocks.



Assemble the quilt top according to the diagram above.
13. Sew all blocks in each diagonal row first. Press.
14. Sew the end setting triangles to each row. Press toward the setting triangle.
15. Sew all rows together, pin at each block intersection. Press.
16. Sew on the four corner triangles last, Press toward the corner triangle.
17. Quilt, bind and enjoy your new Chipper Quilt!
