We honor Dorothy Meyer and Barbara Koerner, who came to Eastminster through the merger with Pt. Breeze Presbyterian Church. They not only gave personally to this fund, but found creative ways to raise money for it. For many years funds were raised from a rummage sale, More recently ECWomen choose to put 10% of the Funds that come in will go toward this Scholarship Fund.

Mission

As women of Eastminster we want to encourage our youth members and regular attenders (between ages of 17-24) to continue their education in colleges, universities, and technical schools.

Guidelines

Priority goes to graduating seniors, other students will be considered if funds are available.

Applicant must be members and/or regular attenders of EPC.

Applicant must be actively involved in EPC.

Applicant must be pursuing a relationship with Jesus Christ.

Application must be completed and received by the committee.

Applications will be reviewed by committee (at least 3 or more members).

Recipients and amounts are to be determined by committee.

Amounts are dependent on available funds.

All scholarships are a onetime gift. Applicants may apply more than once, but priority will go to first time applicants. Scholarship checks may be written out to the student or to the Institution, whichever the applicant requests.

Funds are available for application fees. There is a separate application for this scholarship request. Each applicant may only receive up to 3 application fees. Checks for this portion of the scholarship will be written out to the Educational institution directly.

Gifts can be solicited and given directly to the scholarship fund. However, all scholarship money must be given out in the year it is received or will return to the ECWomen's general fund.
