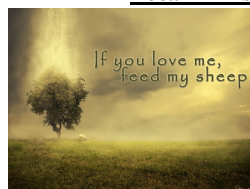

#### Local Ministry Opportunity



Jesus said, "If you love me, feed my sheep." **The Feed My Sheep Movement**, is an outreach ministry for the surrounding community using pre-printed cards. The purpose of the cards, is to share the Word of God with unreached patrons of local restaurants in surrounding cities and towns. Each card has a Bible verse and contact information for our church, as well as the message that the receivers' meal has already been paid for in full. How it works: While you and/or your family are eating a meal away from home, you would discreetly pay the bill for another patron and/or families' table. You would do this by first choosing a person/family that appears to be finishing their meal at another table. Secondly, ask your server to discreetly retrieve that tables total bill. Third, take that total, add a tip for the server and pay the bill in full along with your own bill. After you have paid, ask your server or that tables server, if different, to deliver the card only when that table is ready to pay. This is meant to be done anonymously as to not draw attention to yourself but to serve and honor God. **Feed My Sheep Movement** cards are located at the front of the sanctuary and in the vestibule of the FLC.
