#### **Summary of Pupil Premium Spending 2013/2014**

Objectives in spending Pupil Premium Grant:

Raise attainment and achievement of pupils to at least expected progress through:

- Small, differentiated phonics teaching groups
- Intervention to raise attainment in reading in key stage 1 and 2 through small group and individual support and inference training for comprehension
- Raise attainment in writing in key stage 1 and 2 through targeted support with writing
- Provide social and emotional support/ interventions to improve attendance, punctuality and engagement of some pupils

**Summary of spending actions taken:**

**Staff costs:**

Additional teaching assistant support in Year 2 (30 hours) and for intervention work in Years 3-6 (60 hours) £45,000

Additional days for Attendance officer support £1,000

Learning and Language Specialist advice Half day per week £5095

Reading assistants support 3 half days per week £3,000

**Intervention costs:**

Read, Write Inc. materials

Revision booklets for Year 6 pupils

**Extra-curricular costs:**

Subsidy for Outdoor education residential for Year 4,5 and 6 pupils receiving free school meals

Payment for pupil premium pupils to attend educational visits, transport etc...

**2014-2015 Indicative Allocation Pupil Premium £80,353**

**To ensure that children in receipt of Pupil Premium achieve at least expected standards and that more reach the higher levels.**

**Future actions:**

New Renaissance Reading Intervention Programme to be introduced. This will involve completely re-coding all reading books. Our aim is to improve reading comprehension skills

Provide one-to-one Maths tuition for pupils falling behind or failing to make good progress.

To provide small group teaching of writing where needed to improve standards.
