New England Literary News: Outdoor orators

The words of Sojourner Truth, John F. Kennedy, and other great orators will ring out at Faneuil Marketplace on Thursday. Actor Ben Evett and others from the Poets' Theatre will recite bits and pieces of speeches as part of an outdoors literary series taking place there every Thursday at noon through Aug. 27.

The series is a joint project of the Boston Literary District and Biederman Redevelopment Ventures. The two co-sponsor a similar series at South Station.

Reprising her performance at South Station this spring, pediatrician Lisa Wong, author of "Scales to Scalpels: Doctors Who Practice the Healing Arts of Music and Medicine" (Pegasus), will play the viola as part of a string trio on July 23. Boston poet laureate Danielle Legros Georges will give a reading on Aug. 13.
