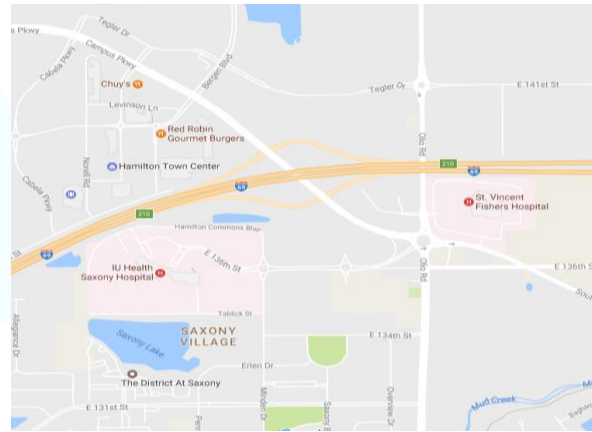
Bill Light, BS, RN, CEN, CPEN, TCRN
