## **Meeting Minutes**

- 2. Discussion/Summary:

Joe May has volunteered to also serve as president for next year. We need ballots prepared by October 31<sup>st</sup>. Joe stated he will acquire access to roster of local ENA members. Joe to send out email and ballot to members. Merry noted that the resolution for state trauma systems network was approved at the September 28<sup>th</sup> Indiana State Nurses Association meeting... resolution was written to be more inclusive, seamless, and "Local to Global". Joe wondered how a trauma system is developed. Merry provided secretary with fliers regarding Trauma Program Manager Course to be held in partnership with the Indiana Rural Health Association annual conference at French Lick, IN June 16-17, 2019. Wabash Valley's Trauma Advisory Council, created in 2010, open to any interested person, alternating meetings between Regional and Union. Kindra Anderson was invited but unable to attend.

- Fund-raising for "Stop the Bleed Kits."
- I-70 Awareness: put up crosses at interchanges at I-70 with areas with high death rates due to motor vehicle accidents to raise awareness
- Fund-raising seasonal themes?
- Trauma systems- Joe would like to informally compare FEMA command systems to the Trauma Systems.
- Contest for t-shirt ideas among Ivy Tech Community College, Indiana State University, and St. Mary's, winner receives scholarship to go to Indiana Rural Health Association conference.
