This contract rider constitutes an agreement between the Purchase Student Senate Association and the performer listed above. By signing this rider, the performer agrees to the following:

This agreement is for a private performance open to students and members of the Purchase College community only. The Performer, Performer's agent(s) or other persons acting on Performer's behalf, may not, under any circumstances, advertise this performance over the internet, on television or radio, through Name of Performer: \_\_\_\_\_

1. a hotline, or by any other means or through any other medium. Any announcement or advertisement of this performance will constitute a breach of contract and will result in the termination of this contract.
2. The Performer must provide to the Sponsoring group, no later than six business days in advance, the names of the performers and any crew/assistants who need to be with them at the time of performance. This list will be delivered by the Sponsoring group to the State University Police no later than five (5) business days prior to the performance.
3. If performance is to be conducted in an outdoor venue, such performance must conclude by 8:00 p.m. (Sunday through Thursday night) or 11:00pm (Friday and Saturday night). If performance is conducted in an indoor venue, such performance must conclude by 12:00a.m. (Sunday through Thursday night) or 2:00a.m. (Friday and Saturday night). The College reserves the right to seek damages against Performer for any injuries or damages to persons or property incurred as a result of such failure to comply.
4. Performers must comply with all federal, New York State, and local laws as well as Purchase college policy while on College grounds. Violators are subject to ejection from the event, arrest and/or prosecution. These laws include, but are not limited to:
  - Underage consumption of alcoholic beverages is prohibited by New York State law and Town of Harrison Law as well as College Policy, and is strictly prohibited.
  - Consumption of alcoholic beverages is limited to designated areas on the college campus (currently only the Hub in Campus North unless otherwise authorized by the College) and is strictly prohibited outside under the law.
  - Possession or use of any illegal substances will result in arrest and prosecution.
  - As an agency of the State of New York, property of the College is also property of the State of New York. Damage to or destruction of property will result in arrest and prosecution.

Any of these conditions (except number 4) may be waived, but only with the specific written permission of the chief of State University Police at Purchase College and/or the Vice President for Student Affairs or their designee at Purchase College. The Sponsoring Group is not authorized to waive any of the clauses within this rider.
