Objective

The WaterWorks Park Education Scholarship strives to help students achieve their goals and become leaders in the community. Description

The WaterWorks Park Education Scholarship provides funding for students currently enrolled or intending to roll in college, university or trade school. Funds will be dispersed directly to the school.

It provides 2 recipients with a financial award up to \$500 towards tuition, books and other school related costs for the Fall 2016/Spring 2017 semesters.

If provides 2 recipients with a financial award up to \$2000 towards tuition, books and other school related costs for the Fall 2016/Spring 2017 semesters.

Eligibility

Eligible applicants of the **\$500 WaterWorks Park Education Scholarship** must meet all of the following criteria:

- Current WaterWorks Park Employee
- Have been in good standing throughout employment
- Employed for 3 months (1 season)
- Have a minimum, cumulative GPA of 2.5
- Must be currently enrolled and are/will be taking classes for the Fall 2016. Qualified institutions are regionally accredited, are nonprofit, offer the majority of their classes at a physical campus within the United States, and disburse Federal Student Aid.
- You may only receive one \$500 scholarship in a lifetime.

Eligible applicants of the **\$2000 WaterWorks Park Education Scholarship** must meet all of the following criteria:

- Employee of WaterWorks Park for the past 2 seasons.
- Have been in good standing throughout employment
- Employed for 6 months or more (2 seasons)
- Have a minimum, cumulative GPA of 2.5
- Must be currently enrolled and are/will be taking classes for the Fall 2016. Qualified institutions are regionally accredited, are nonprofit, offer the majority of their classes at a physical campus within the United States, and disburse Federal Student Aid.
- You may only receive one \$2000 scholarship in a lifetime.
