

The Center for New York City Affairs examined Department of Education course data on 393 schools that served grades 9-12 in the 2013-14 school year. Transfer schools and new schools that hadn't graduated their first class were excluded from the data set, but are included in this list for informational purposes.

Schools that offered International Baccalaureate or Advanced Placement classes are indicated in the columns on the right. The DOE course data does not indicate whether a school offers college-level courses (typically on college campuses). However, such "early college" schools are labeled with a dagger on this list.
