Dear Children's Pastor,

It's time to register for 2018 Kid's Winter Camps at Sugar Pine. Our team is excited and ready to partner with your ministry to **Impact Lives for CHRIST.** We are maintaining the **same low rates as last year.**

We are offering two exciting **2018 Kid's Winter Camps:**

Kid's #1: January 26th – 28th

Price for this weekend is \$139 camper / \$50 adults

Kid's #2: February 9th – 11th

Price for this weekend is \$139 camper / \$50 adults

The following explains the registration process:

- **COMPLETE THE KID'S WINTER CAMP CONTRACT:** (available on-line) Mail, fax or email your completed camp contract to info@sugarpine.org. Mail a \$50 non-refundable deposit for each camper. You are responsible **for payment in full** for your contracted registrations.
- **PROMOTE YOUR 2018 WINTER RETREAT:** You can access promotional Posters, Postcards, and Parent Information Letters through our website (www.sugarpine.org). These forms allow you to personalize your own camper cost information.

- **Register Campers and Cabin Leaders:** When we receive your contract, we will email a link and a group code for you to give to your staff and families so they can register online. **There will be a \$15 late fee added to registrations submitted 20 days or less prior to camp; so have your families register early.**

PAYMENT: Prior to camp, request a check from your church and either mail or bring it with you. If you have additional campers, you can pay for them separately upon arrival. However, please let us know in advance to ensure housing. You are responsible **for payment in full** for your contracted registrations.

PRE-CAMP HEALTH SCREENING: The State of California requires that a health screening must be completed within 24 hours of camp by the parent and/or group leader. If a camper has a fever, head lice, flu-like symptoms, vomiting, diarrhea, pink eye, open wounds or sores they cannot attend camp until all of their symptoms have passed. REGISTRATION TIMES: Friday beginning at 5:30 p.m. An optional pizza dinner will be served from 5:30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m.

DEPARTURE TIME: Camp ends immediately following lunch on Sunday by 12:30 p.m.

CAMP ARRIVAL/DEPARTURE: All campers and/or group supervisors must check-in at the Welcome Center located near the main parking lot, the designated drop-off and pick-up location for buses, vans and privately owned vehicles. Once campers/groups are registered and luggage is unloaded, vehicles will be redirected to the appropriate long-term parking location. **If you are arriving on a bus, please advise us prior to camp.**

MEDICATIONS: The Camp Health Supervisor will collect all medications during check-in. The exception would be an inhaler or EpiPen. **All medications and dosages must be clearly labeled in their original container. If parents are sending over-the-counter medications, directions and dosage must be in writing and signed by the parent.**

PARENT HEALTHCARE NOTIFICATION: In the event a camper becomes ill or suffers an injury during their stay at camp, parents will be notified by phone from; the Camp's Health Supervisor their supervising pastor or a designated camp employee. Supervising group leaders will be notified in person.
