

Privacy Policy

Online Privacy Statement

Information Gathered and How It's Used

Users to the public areas of the CHC website browse anonymously. You may use this website as a member of the general public for information purposes without volunteering personally identifiable information.

Third party vendors providing services in connection with this website may have access to Personal Information. It is CHC's policy to require such vendors to hold Personal Information in strict confidence.
